**301. PLANNING APPLICATIONS**

- a. **Application 18/01200/HSE** at 2 Wadsworth Lane, Hebden Bridge, HX7 8DL for Addition of new access door to ground floor and first floor gable end, new enclosed external stairway mounted to gable end. Conversion rear 2/3 of existing basement garage, to usable living space, retaining existing garage door. New window to side gable at garage level. Replacement of existing rear balcony with larger balcony (Birchcliffe).

**311. MISANDRY**

Cllr Bampton Smith explained her request that Misandry be treated by Hebden Royd Town Council in the same way that Misogyny is treated within Hebden Royd Town Council.

A lengthy discussion followed:

Cllr Needham didn't want to see anyone to be a victim of hatred because of their gender, he supports all genders, be they men or women but the statement was to support women and supporting men in the same way would be disproportionate to the support needed.

Cllr Stow advised that the statement was issued to highlight hatred towards women and not to highlight the policy that already existed with HRTC being a fair and equal employer and organisation.

Cllr Boggis argued that you cannot support one gender and not the other.

Cllr Timbers stated that hatred is a rare experience for men to face and was nothing like as frequent as that faced by women. The statement was to recognise this imbalance and the difficulties that women face.

Cllr Phillips highlighted the exploitation of power.

Cllr Trickett would like to see the statement refer to all and for all.

Cllr Fraser saw the statement referring to the attitudes towards women and to seek an end to their exploitation.

Seconded by Cllr Boggis that: the same consideration be given to men as was to women in the recent HRTC statement concerning misogyny.
