The proposed light commercial use would generate noise for nearby residents with the topography of the area likely to magnify this issue and transmit disturbance a significant distance from the site.

Finally, the established adjacent residential development at Longstaff Court has already started a move away from light industrial premises in the area the Town Council would like to see this move continue.
