**151. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE NOTES OF THE ADVISORY

152. BUDGET UPDATE

The budget was presented and current planned expenditure outlined. Hebden's Happy Hounds has an underspend all other projects re currently on budget. The full budget for Festive lighting is unlikely to be spent this year,

153. PROJECT UPDATES AND FUTURE PLANNING

To receive updates and decide on actions relating to the following planned events;

a) Pumpkin Festival

An overview was given of the event which is planned to take place on Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd October. Working with Sand in Your Eye to deliver a climate based event, with an overall theme of Hebden Bridge 2024. Following a meeting with Cllr Needham and Sand in your eye,

additional ideas were presented to enhance the event including a video time capsule working with Pennine Horizons to capture pledges made by people at the event to be shown in 2084.

RESOLVED: this additional activity should be supported and £2000 made available to support this. Whilst there is the budget available within Project & Events, it was suggested that the Climate Emergency Committee might like to support this.

b) Christmas – Mytholmroyd

An overview was given of the event which will take place on Saturday 19th November, working in partnership with Royd Regeneration and Light Up the Valley. The event will be held at Mytholmroyd Community Centre for the first time. There will be a range of entertainment, market and switch on event.

c) Christmas – Hebden Bridge

An overview was given of the event which will take place on Thursday 24th November, working in partnership with Royd Regeneration and Light Up the Valley. The event will be held in St Georges Square, with additional activities in the Town Hall and St Pol Car Park.

d) Christmas Lighting

The three year lease on the Market Street/New Road scheme is up for renewal, additional decorations were also considered for the Christmas trees.

RESOLVED: that this scheme should not be replaced with new features, but that the existing features should be retained for another year with a 20% reduction. Councillors would like to see an example of the new style tree decorations before committing to purchase.

154. EXTERNAL PROJECT FEEDBACK

Cllr Wood presented feedback on the Rise Up Mytholmroyd Music Festival expressing a desire to run this event again. The associated costs were outlined along with potential ideas for 2023 such as ticket prices and how to work with venues. It was suggested that the Rotary Club of Hebden Bridge may support this event.

RESOLVED: that the event should consider how it may operate in 2023 and that it may be suitable for it to approach Community Funding for a Grant to support the event.
